

PORT OF HOUSTON TOUR BOAT VESSEL TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION HIGHLIGHTS

- Vessel within budget that best fits specifications
- Bidders may deviate from specification by adding manufacturers / model numbers to Maker's List but require justification for Owner's Consideration. Proposer shall make clear any major deviations.
- Budget Range \$4MM to \$6MM
- Hull Type Catamaran
- Hull Material Aluminum or Steel or Combination of Steel Hulls and Aluminum Freeboard / Topside
- Vessel Shall Comply With US Cfr Subchapter T Small Passenger Vessels (Under 100 Gross Tons) 46 Cfr Part 175 Thru 185 For Up To 150 Passengers
- Design shall allow for Americans With Disabilities [Ada]



PORT OF HOUSTON TOUR BOAT VESSEL TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION HIGHLIGHTS

- Normal Operating Profile Is (2) tours at 2 hours each per day, seven days per week, 14 nautical miles round trip per tour on battery only
- 2 Hour Recharge Time From Shore Power between morning and afternoon normal tours each day
- Longer Barbour's Cut Tour Is Approximately 6 hours and 40 nautical miles round trip on battery and generator
- Trial Speed 12 Knots
- Service Speed At Full Load And 2/3 MCR [Maximum Continuous Rate] Power – 10 Knots


